

Organise your cockpit!

Terracycle launch a new system for accessory mounting for recumbent trikes - or anything else you can imagine!

It's a common problem for recumbent riders - there often aren't enough places to mount all the gadgets, mirrors and lights you might want to use. Now **Terracycle**, makers of accessory mounts and chain idlers amongst many things, have come up with a solution, the **Cockpit Mount**.



This is comprised of a set of tubes and clamps to fit on any recumbent, direct or indirect steering, which hold an asymmetric 'T' bar, big enough to house computer, GPS, lights etc.





The clamps are cleverly open-ended, so that you don't have to remove stuff already on the handlebars to fit them, and all the parts are available separately, so whatever your set up, you should be able to build a mount that suits you. The clamps and short lengths of tube can even be used on any upright's handlebars to lift a light above a basket or bar bag:



The cockpit mount can be purchased direct from Terracycle, or European customers may wish to use EU distributor [lclletta](#) for faster shipping and no customs delays.
